

ORDINANCE No. 186214

*Authorize application to the Federal Emergency Management Agency Emergency Management Performance Grant for an award in the amount of \$369,765 to administer an integrated all hazard emergency management program for the City (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Federal Emergency Management Agency's Emergency Management Performance Grant (EMPG) provides financial and technical assistance through their Fiscal Year 2013 grant. These funds are provided for the development of an all hazard emergency management capability to promote planning, response, exercise, training and community outreach.
2. Grant funds are budgeted for one half of the cost of three Portland Bureau of Emergency Management (PBEM) positions, one half of the annual rent for PBEM office space, one half the cost of a Hazard Mitigation Plan Update consultant and one half of Emergency Coordination Center information technology operational support. All funds received through the EMPG program will be provided on a reimbursable basis and will be matched 50% in the form of salary, benefits, and materials and services in the FY 2013-14 budget of the Portland Bureau of Emergency Management.
3. City Code requires that grant applications be approved by ordinance prior to submission. Due to the short timeline for submission of the application, an ordinance was not filed. PBEM is submitting to Council for retroactive approval of the application by ordinance.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Mayor and Portland Bureau of Emergency Management are hereby authorized to make application to the Federal Emergency Management Agency Emergency Management Performance Grant for a grant in the amount of \$369,765.
- b. The Mayor is authorized to provide such information and assurances as are required for the grant period.
- c. The OMF Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.

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Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists in that any delay in the application for this grant will result in losing the opportunity for funding these activities; therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.


