ORDINANCE No. 186237

Authorize Intergovernmental Agreement with Metropolitan Service District for maintenance of a computerized mapping system for Portland Fire & Rescue emergency response vehicles not to exceed \$20,000 per year (Ordinance; Contract 30003562)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The City and Metropolitan Service District (Metro) find it mutually beneficial for both governments to cooperate in mapping the metropolitan area in order to enhance the prompt delivery of emergency response.
- 2. Portland Fire & Rescue (PF&R) has a need to have current mapping and system information available in electronic format in its emergency response apparatus.
- 3. Metro has the current ability and capacity to maintain the components of a mapping and data system for the City.
- 4. PF&R has sufficient resources in its FY 2013-14 and FY2014-15 budget to allow for these costs.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. The Commissioner in Charge, Auditor, Fire Chief and CGIS Manager are authorized to execute an Intergovernmental Agreement with Metro for the maintenance of a computerized mapping system for use in emergency response vehicles for Portland Fire & Rescue, substantially in accordance with the terms and conditions as shown in Exhibit A, attached hereto, not to exceed \$20,000 per year, for fiscal years 2013-2014 and 2014-2015.
