ORDINANCE No. 186269

Amend contract with Hillsboro Landfill for multi-bureau contaminated media disposal in the amount of \$1,000,000 (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 31000155)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Contaminated Media (CM) generated during City projects must be disposed of according to applicable federal, state, and local laws and regulations intended to protect the public from exposure to harmful chemicals and substances.
- 2. This contract facilitates the City's ability to properly dispose of CM in an expeditious manner and at a reasonable cost. Proper CM disposal for City projects must occur regardless of whether or not this contract is in place.
- 3. The Coordinated Site Analysis (CSA) program in BES provides all City Bureaus with contaminated media (CM) disposal services for CIP and Operating Projects through the Hillsboro Landfill Contract 31000155 executed in April 2010.
- 4. The original contract amount was \$500,000 with an option to renew the agreement for an additional 4 years, with a not to exceed value of \$2,500,000.
- 5. Amendment No. 1 extended the contract expiration date through April 14, 1015 and increased the value of the contract by \$500,000 per year, for a new total contract amount of \$2,500,000, and was based on disposal volumes during previous years by the Coordinated Site Analysis section of BES/Pollution Prevention Services.
- 6. The balance of the contract has run out prematurely due to unanticipated contract usages by PBOT Maintenance and by large projects using this service through CSA.
- 7. In order to continue to provide this service to its customers, as well as to allow for utilization by other City of Portland bureaus, CSA would like to increase the value of the contract by \$1,000,000 to last to its expiration date of April 14, 2015.
- 8. Funds are available through the various CIP and Operating budgets within the Bureaus that utilize this service.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Commissioner in Charge is authorized to execute a contract amendment with Hillsboro Landfill for the purpose described in Section 1, in the amount of \$1,000,000.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.
