TO THE COUNCIL:

The Portland Bureau of Transportation has planned the conversion of 46,700 street lights from high pressure sodium to energy efficient Light-Emitting Diodes (LED) over a period of three to five years. On December 19, 2012, City Council passed Ordinance 185837 authorizing the City to issue revenue bonds for the Lighting Efficiency Program. This Program includes street lights, poles and other outdoor lighting systems. The Lighting Efficiency Program will lower maintenance and operational costs and reduce the amount of electrical energy consumption becoming eligible for \$500,000 energy incentives form the Energy Trust of Oregon.

On March 20, 2013, City Council passed Ordinance 185929 authorizing the Chief Procurement Officer to facilitate the use of a competitive solicitation process for the purchase of LED equipment for the lighting efficiency program for the Bureau of Transportation.

On April 16, 2013, the Chief Procurement Officer advertised ITB No. 115460, for the purchase of LED equipment for the Lighting Efficiency Program for the Bureau of Transportation and thirteen (13) bids were received. The bids were reviewed in accordance with Portland City Code 5.33. Leotek Electronics USA Corp. was identified as the lowest responsive, responsible bidder. On August 22, 2013, the City issued a Notice of Intent to Award a price agreement to Leotek Electronics USA Corp. Three (3) protests were received. The protests were reviewed, analyzed and resolved with responses sent to the protesting bidders on September 10, 2013.

Leotek Electronics USA Corp. has a current City of Portland Business License Tax Account, is in compliance with the Equal Benefits Program, and their EEO Certification is current through December 2, 2013. Leotek Electronics USA Corp. is not a State of Oregon Certified MWESB contractor. The Bureau's level of confidence in the cost estimates for this project is High.

The Chief Procurement Officer recommends the City Council authorize the execution of a price agreement with Leotek Electronics USA Corp. to provide LED equipment for the Lighting Efficiency Program at a contractual cost not to exceed \$7,500,000.
