ORDINANCE No. 186285

* Authorize application to the Federal Emergency Management Agency for a grant in the amount of \$240,000 to update the City's Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Portland's Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan is a city-wide strategy to reduce the City's vulnerability to natural hazards. It outlines management actions, regulatory strategies, and capital investments to reduce risks and improve resilience. Projects outlined in the plan are eligible for pre-disaster mitigation grants from the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA). The City's current plan will expire in 2015.
- 2. The Oregon Office of Emergency Management will administer the grant for FEMA, with Portland Bureau of Emergency Management acting as the sub-grantee.
- 3. Local match in the amount of \$80,000 will be provided by funds from FY 2013-14 bureau program budget appropriations, and in-kind contributions in the form of salary, benefits, and materials and services in the FY 2013-14 budget of the Bureau of Planning and Sustainability and the Bureau of Environmental Services.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to make application to FEMA and OEM for a grant in the amount of \$240,000.
- b. The Mayor is authorized to provide such information and assurances as are required for the grant period.
- c. The OMF Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because the grant application is due by October 17th, 2013. Therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
