These are housekeeping changes to remove outdated language. "Fareless Square" and the Free Rail Zone" are no longer applicable, so the term "Downtown Core" is more accurate and understandable. Section 16.40.480 B. conflicts with approved Section 16.40.460. Several

different versions of the Code language were circulated during Council consideration in 2009. Section 16.40.480 B. was discussed at Council and highlighted for removal, but remained in the published version as an oversight. At the December 15, 2009 Private For-Hire Transportation Board meeting, it was noted that section 16.40.480 B of the Code language was left in the published version of the Code only as an oversight because of the several different versions circulating during Council consideration.

7. BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS

The Private For-Hire Transportation Code Chapter 16.40 makes reference to the TriMet definition of "Fareless Square" in several sections regulating fares. These housekeeping changes replace the outdated term "Fareless Square" with a definition of the "Downtown Core," which is defined with the same boundaries as the definition previously used for "Fareless Square." Neither the area nor the regulations are changing; the wording is changed to eliminate the outdated term. Other housekeeping changes include a clear reference to the definition of "prearranged" transportation, which is provided in administrative rule, as well as elimination of a paragraph (16.40.480.B) that is inconsistent with the Code language approved in 2009, and which was retained from a previous draft in error.

These are housekeeping changes with no financial impact.

Approve housekeeping language changes to provide clarity and consistency within the Private For-Hire Transportation regulations.
