## ORDINANCE No. 186719

\*Pay claim of Kristy Galvan in the sum of \$50,000, involving the Portland Police Bureau. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Kristy Galvan, through her attorney, Charese Rohny, has filed a discrimination and retaliation claim against the City related to her employment.
- 2. The claim has been investigated by Risk Management Services and the City Attorney's Office. The investigation indicates there is some risk that the City may be found liable. Therefore, in order to avoid the expense of litigation and risk of an adverse outcome, we feel it is prudent to compromise the claim at this time.
- 3. Risk Management Services and the City Attorney's Office recommend the claim be compromised for the total sum of \$50,000, subject to the claimant providing the City with a release in a form to be approved by the City Attorney.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor and the Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver a check in the amount of \$50,000 made payable to Kristy Galvan and Charese Rohny Law Office LLC.
- b. Risk Management Services will execute a payment authorization in the amount set forth in sub-paragraph (a) above.
- Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists in order to avoid undue and costly delay in settling this claim; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.


