ORDINANCE No. 166186

*Accept the gift of a laser radar gun from GEICO Insurance Company for the Police Bureau (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- GEICO Insurance Company has offered to donate to the City of Portland 1. Bureau of Police an LTI 20-20 Laser Speed Gun (radar) valued at approximately \$3,800.00. The cost per unit puts this equipment beyond the reach of the current Traffic Division budget.
- 2. The Laser Speed Gun will be primarily used to enhance neighborhood speed enforcement based on complaints from citizens about problem areas.
- The City's only financial obligation in accepting this gift will be the costs 3. of routine maintenance. Sufficient funds are available within the Bureau of Police FY 92/93 budget to cover such costs.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- The LTI 20-20 Laser Speed Gun offered as a gift to the City by Geico a. Insurance Company be accepted.
- b. The Bureau of Police shall be responsible for the care, maintenance, and use of the Laser Speed Gun.

Section 2: The Council declares that an emergency exists because delay in the acceptance of this gift would result in delay of the utilization of this gift for the good of the City: therefore, this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
