

ORDINANCE No. 188021

*Pay claim of Samuel Sachs in the sum of \$130,000 involving the Parks Bureau. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Samuel Sachs has filed a claim against the City for damages related to his employment with Portland Parks and Recreation.
2. The claim has been investigated by Risk Management Services. The investigation indicates there is risk the City may be found liable. Therefore, in order to avoid the risk of extensive litigation costs and an adverse jury award, we feel it is prudent to compromise the claim at this time.
3. Risk Management Services recommends the claim be compromised for the total sum of \$130,000.00, subject to the claimant providing the City with a release in a form to be approved by the City Attorney.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor and the Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver two checks in the following amounts:
 1. one check in the amount of \$86,666.67 made payable to Samuel Sachs and
 2. one check in the amount of \$43,333.33 made payable to The Law Office of Daniel Snyder.
- b. Risk Management Services will execute a payment authorization in the amount set forth in sub-paragraph (a) above.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists in order to avoid undue and costly delay in settling this claim; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.

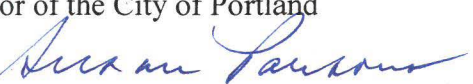

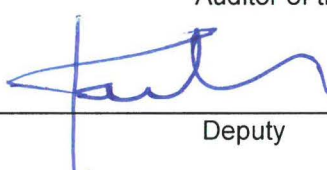
