## ORDINANCE No. 188022

\*Authorize CityFleet to purchase replacement Bridge Inspection Crane for use by Bureau of Transportation at \$811,932. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

## Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The CityFleet Division of the Bureau of Internal Business Services replaces all City vehicles based on an annual replacement plan.
- 2. CityFleet has reviewed the standard replacement schedule and the condition of Bridge Inspection Crane (Vehicle 045001).
- 3. It has been determined that Vehicle #045001 meets or exceeds the established criteria and needs to be replaced for the Portland Bureau of Transportation (PBOT) Exhibit A attached.
- 4. A Bridge Inspection Crane with an extended reach is required to improve the bridge inspection process.
- 5. The City now desires to purchase this vehicle.

## NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The CityFleet Division of the Bureau of Internal Business Services, OMF, is hereby authorized to purchase this vehicle for use by the Portland Bureau of Transportation per the listed request identified in the attached, Exhibit A.
- b. The Mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to pay for said purchase from the CityFleet replacement fund.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because delay in proceeding with the purchase would result in additional expense and unnecessarily deprive the City of the use of this vehicle at an early date; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
