Authorize a contract with the lowest responsive bidder and provide payment for the construction of the Cornell Road Services - Macleay Park Project at an estimated cost of \$600,000 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. A temporary 2-inch water main currently serves eight customers along NW Cornell Road and said main is located in pathway and natural areas in Macleay Park with poor access for equipment and is in poor condition and must be replaced.
- 2. The Water Bureau requires construction services to construct a replacement for the temporary water main.
- 3. The construction work includes installation of 7,100 feet of new water main appurtenances in NW Cornell Road beginning at NW Eloise Lane and ending near 5240 NW Cornell Road.
- 4. The engineer's estimate for the contract action is \$600,000 with a high confidence level. Funding for this project (W01682) has been approved in the FY 2016-17 Budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. Upon the Council's acceptance of the Chief Procurement Officer's report recommending the lowest responsible bidder, the Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to negotiate and execute a contract, provided the contract has been approved as to form by the City Attorney's office.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver checks chargeable to the Water Fund when demand is presented and approved by the proper authorities.
