Community Engagement Plan

I am pleased to submit for your consideration the Office of Neighborhood Involvement's Housing Emergency Community Engagement Plan. As part of the FY17 budget approval on May 18, 2016, City Council directed the Office of Neighborhood Involvement to work with the Portland Housing Bureau, the City and County Joint Office for Homeless Services, and A Home for Everyone to develop a community engagement proposal prior to spending \$350,000 allocated in its budget for this purpose.

Over the past several months, over 55 neighborhood and community-based organization leaders participated in seven planning meetings, including four ONI BAC meetings, to further develop the proposal. Per direction from the Portland Housing Bureau and Commissioner Saltzman's office, ONI staff and the community stakeholder group worked in close collaboration with Marc Jolin, director of the City and County Joint Office for Homeless Services, and A Home for Everyone.

The funds allocated by Council will be used for outreach and information sharing in coordination with relevant government agencies about the City and County's action plan, building community and neighborhood-based organizational capacity including leadership development and public policy advocacy efforts, and, funding small grant projects to engage more people in creative community-based projects addressing the housing crisis.

Specific funding allocations and draft performance measures by which grantees will be evaluated are provided in the attached exhibits.
