

ORDINANCE No. 188042

*Extend contract with Online Business Systems, Inc. to provide systems design, maintenance and programming services for five years for the Fire and Police Disability and Retirement Application by \$500,000 for a not-to-exceed total of \$1,150,000 (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 30002409)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. As authorized by Ordinance No. 184986, the City entered into Contract No. 30002409 with Online Business Systems, Inc., effective October 15, 2011, to provide PTE services to migrate the FPDR database to a new technology platform and to provide ongoing systems design, maintenance, and programming services.
2. The City wishes to extend the term of the Contract for an additional five years to allow continued use of the services to support this database.
3. With the proposed amendment, the not-to-exceed value of the Contract shall be increased by \$500,000 to cover the additional five years of services, to a contractual total of \$1,150,000.
4. On September 27, 2016, the Board of Trustees of the FPDR by its Resolution No. 512 approved the extension to the Contract and the increase in the Contract amount.
5. Funds are available in the FPDR budget.
6. An appropriate form of amendment to the Contract is attached hereto as Exhibit "A".

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The City's Chief Procurement Officer is hereby authorized to execute a Contract amendment, provided that it is approved as to form by the City Attorney, to extend the term and to increase the not-to-exceed value of the Contract.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because the City needs to act promptly in order to ensure continuity of the Services. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.


