Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

The purpose of this legislation is to amend a price agreement with DJ's Electrical, Inc., in order to provide additional streetlight pole bonding and grounding services for streetlight maintenance and upgrades, and to qualify for \$209,309.00 in Oregon Department of Energy, Energy Incentives Program tax credits.

Portland Bureau of Transportation (PBOT) provides and maintains the City of Portland's street lighting system infrastructure, including lighting fixtures and supplies. PBOT is replacing aging and failing street lighting fixtures with more energy efficient and cost effective LED lighting.

This legislation does not change any City policies.

No revenues will be impacted by this legislation.

Financial and budgetary impacts:

Funding for purchases will come from the approved PBOT budget. Costs to the City related to this legislation are not expected to exceed \$1,250,000.00 over a one-year period.

No positions will be created, eliminated or re-classifies as a result of this legislation.

Community impacts and community involvement:
