## ORDINANCE No. 188059

Authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with Clackamas County for construction and sharing of data network resources in the amount of \$230,000. (Ordinance)

### The City of Portland ordains:

#### Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Reliable data communications between the Bureau of Environmental Services (BES) Operations Building at the Columbia Boulevard Wastewater Treatment Plant, the Tryon Creek Wastewater Treatment Plant (TCWTP), wastewater collection pump stations, and flow monitoring and control facilities are critical to the success of BES' mission to protect public health, water quality and the environment.
- 2. BES Staff and Clackamas County Staff have been collaborating to complete a regional fiber optic cable data communications network loop on both sides of the Willamette River from downtown Portland to Oregon City that will provide reliable fiber optic communications with the TCWTP and will improve data network reliability for other BES remote sites.
- 3. BES requires an Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) with Clackamas County pursuant to ORS 190.003 to 190.110 to provide for the construction of, and to formalize the shared use of, data network resources.
- 4. The TCWTP Fiber Optic Expansion project is included in the Adopted Budget of the City of Portland for Fiscal Year 2016-17.
- 5. The estimated cost for Portland's share of the data network expansion covered under the IGA is \$230,000. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY2016-17 Budget, Bureau of Environmental Services, WBS Elements E07543 and E10752.

#### NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Director of the Bureau of Environmental Services, or their designee, is authorized to execute an IGA with Clackamas County, in a form substantially in accordance with the agreement attached as Exhibit A, for the purpose described in Section 1, in the amount of \$230,000.
- b. The Director of BES is authorized to execute amendments to the IGA provided the aggregate cost of all amendments does not exceed 25% of the original amount.
- c. The Mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.
