## The City of Portland ordains:

## Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Approximately 15,000 feet of combined sewer pipe in the north Portland neighborhoods of King, Piedmont, and Humboldt are in deteriorated condition and need to rehabilitated or replaced.
- 2. Environmental Services along with Murray, Smith & Associates has prepared plans and specifications for rehabilitating or replacing the deteriorated sewer pipe, including sewer manholes and service laterals.
- The estimated cost is \$3,780,000. To comply with Council Resolution No. 36430 this estimate 3. has been assigned a level of confidence of High.
- Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FYs 2016, and 2017 Budgets, Bureau 4. of Environmental Services, WBS Element E10698

- The Commissioner-in-Charge is authorized to execute a contract for the purposes described in a. Section 1, with the lowest responsive bidder, in the amount of \$3,780,000.
