

ORDINANCE No. 188063

Authorize contract with the lowest responsive bidder for the construction of the Woodlawn-King Alleys Sewer Rehabilitation project No. E10698 for \$3,780,000 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Approximately 15,000 feet of combined sewer pipe in the north Portland neighborhoods of King, Piedmont, and Humboldt are in deteriorated condition and need to be rehabilitated or replaced.
2. Environmental Services along with Murray, Smith & Associates has prepared plans and specifications for rehabilitating or replacing the deteriorated sewer pipe, including sewer manholes and service laterals.
3. The estimated cost is \$3,780,000. To comply with Council Resolution No. 36430 this estimate has been assigned a level of confidence of High.
4. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FYs 2016, and 2017 Budgets, Bureau of Environmental Services, WBS Element E10698

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Commissioner-in-Charge is authorized to execute a contract for the purposes described in Section 1, with the lowest responsive bidder, in the amount of \$3,780,000.
- b. The Mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to pay for the contract from the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget.




