ORDINANCE No. 188075

*Authorize purchase of 24 vehicles and equipment for use by the Portland Bureau of Transportation at \$1,500,000 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The CityFleet Division of the Bureau of Internal Business Services recognizes the need to purchase twenty-four vehicles and equipment to be used by the Portland Bureau of Transportation (PBOT).
- 2. These twenty-four vehicles and equipment will be used for street repair, safe routes to school, sidewalk completion, crash corridor safety improvements, reducing bicycle/car conflicts, and intersection safety improvements for the City.
- 3. It has been determined that twenty-four vehicles and pieces of equipment need to be purchased for the PBOT Exhibit A attached.
- 4. The City now desires to purchase these vehicles and equipment for \$1,500,000 funded by PBOT.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The CityFleet Division of the Bureau of Internal Business Services, OMF, is hereby authorized to purchase these vehicles and equipment for use by PBOT per the listed requests identified in the attached, Exhibit A.
- b. The Mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to pay for said purchase from the PBOT budget.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because delay in proceeding with the purchase would result in additional expense and unnecessarily deprive the City of the use of this vehicle at an early date; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
