

ORDINANCE No. 188076

*Authorize price agreements with Centennial School District for the Afterschool At-Risk Meal and Snack Program. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Portland Parks & Recreation has since 2010 been a sponsor of an Afterschool At-Risk Meal and Snack Program, administered by the Oregon Department of Education's Child Nutrition Program. Through this entitlement program, children enrolled in afterschool education or enrichment programs receive free nutritious meals and snacks. Program sponsors are eligible for federal reimbursement of costs.
2. In 2010 Portland Parks & Recreation entered into a Sponsor Agreement with the Oregon Department of Education, dated May 3, 2010, that provides for federal reimbursement of the costs of providing the meals (Sponsor Agreement) The Sponsor Agreement is effective perpetually unless terminated by the parties.
3. St. Johns Community Center, Peninsula Community Center and Charles Jordan Community Center are participating in the program for the 2016-2017 school year.
4. Portland Parks & Recreation provides meals for this program via a vended meal agreement with Centennial School District. This agreement is entered into annually.
5. For the 2016-2017 school year, Parks expects to spend \$48,000 to provide meals, with \$46,000 of this cost to be recovered through federal reimbursement from the Oregon Department of Education.
6. As this is a funded, ongoing program that Portland Parks & Recreation wishes to continue this year and future years, it would be efficient for Council to authorize future vended meal agreements with Centennial School District.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. In FY 2016-17 and future years, the Portland Parks & Recreation Director is hereby authorized to enter into vended meal agreements with Centennial School District, in a form substantially in accordance with the agreement attached as Exhibit A, so long as Parks has adequate funding, though the Sponsor Agreement or budget allocations for this program.


