ORDINANCE No. 188085

*Authorize a three-year contract with Michael Gennaco dba OIR Group for the review of closed officer-involved shooting and in-custody death administrative investigations for a total not-to-exceed amount of \$140,000 (Ordinance; Contract No. 30005510)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. City Code authorizes the City Auditor's Independent Police Review (IPR) to hire a qualified expert to review closed investigations pertaining to officer-involved shootings (OIS) and in-custody deaths (ICD) on an ongoing basis. Expert assessments are necessary to ensure that the Portland Police Bureau (PPB) is made aware of any emerging best practices related to deadly force, including police practices that increase officer safety and reduce the necessity of deadly force. The public is also well served by having an independent expert regularly demonstrate that PPB has provided a reasonable and appropriate level of evaluation of officer-involved shootings and in-custody deaths.
- 2. The services were advertised under RFP No. 00000369 and one responsive proposal was received. The selection committee reviewed and scored the proposal in accordance with PCC 5.68 and selected Michael Gennaco dba OIR Group.
- 3. The City desires to enter into a PTE contract with Michael Gennaco dba OIR Group with a not-to-exceed contract amount of \$140,000.
- 4. The M/W/ESB participation in this contract is zero.
- 5. Sufficient funding resides in the IPR account 521000 (cost center AUCA000002) beginning in FY 2016-2017.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council Directs:

- a. The Chief Procurement Officer (CPO) is authorized to enter in a contract with Michael Gennaco dba OIR Group for services in accordance with contract No. 30005510 attached hereto as Exhibit A.
- b. The CPO is further authorized to execute amendments to this contract that do not exceed 25% of the original contract amount.
- c. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver checks payable to Michael Gennaco dba OIR Group chargeable to the Office of the City Auditor, Independent Police Review, when demand is presented and approved by the proper authorities.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay in funding would interrupt Michael Gennaco dba OIR Group's ability to begin the reviews in a timely manner. Therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
