Re: Support for the Forest Park Management Plan

Forest Park has been identified as an urban wilderness protected by land use law as stated in the Forest Park Natural Resources Management Plan, (FPNRM).

For the past 73 years, this unique preserve has been managed with conservation and restoration of native resources as the highest priority.

As a result, this 5000 acre oasis has more native species than any other city park in the nation. Indeed, scientists have determined that Forest Park has more interior forest habitat than any other city park in the world.

The Management Plan calls for passive recreational use that does not degrade natural resources and requires that trails be safe for all users. However, this habitat and many of the species it supports are threatened by the unauthorized use of trails.

It is our understanding that plans to build new trails for single track biking will be presented to the Bureau of Development Services for permitting. The Portland Garden Club supports efforts to uphold the goals of the Forest Park Natural Resources

Management Plan, which states there can be no bicycling on trails that are less than 8 feet wide. This means single track cycling, which by definition occurs on trails 18" to 3' wide, is not consistent with the FPNRPM. We oppose the development of trails for single track bicycling.

Activities that threaten user safety or harm the health of Forest Park must be prohibited.
