## ORDINANCE No. 188087

\* Authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Multnomah County District Attorney to partially fund the cost of employing three full-time equivalent District Attorney Investigators not to exceed \$265,405 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

## Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Portland Police Bureau and the Multnomah County District Attorney's Office (MCDA) have traditionally contracted for PPB to provide three police investigators to perform work for the MCDA.
- 2. The Police Bureau requires that the assigned police investigators return to assignments within Police Bureau.
- 3. The City recognizes the continued obligation for service of subpoenas by MCDA and is willing to partially fund those services.
- 4. MCDA agrees to perform the Police Bureau's obligation of personal service of subpoenas and agrees to additional ministerial functions historically performed by the police investigators.
- 5. The prorated cost in FY 2016-17 is estimated at \$265,405.
- 6. Sufficient funding resides in existing FY 2016-17 Police Bureau appropriation.
- 7. It is beneficial to the City that this amendment may be authorized as quickly as possible to avoid a lapse in the service.

## NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. That the Commissioner-in-charge is authorized to execute an agreement between the City and Multnomah County as outlined in a form similar to the Agreement attached as Exhibit A, at a cost not to exceed \$265,405.
- b. The Mayor and the Auditor hereby are authorized to pay for the contract from the FY 2016-17 Budget.
- c. The Chief of Police is authorized to execute amendments to the Agreement to renew annually at an annual amount of \$374,266 plus annual increases for cost of living and benefits.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because delay may cause a lapse in service. Therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
