

**ORDINANCE No. 188088**

Amend an Intergovernmental Agreement with Multnomah County for the Sex Buyers Accountability and Diversion Program (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 30002122)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The City of Portland (City) and Multnomah County (County) are committed to addressing the problem of prostitution in the city.
2. The Sex Buyers Accountability and Diversion Program (SBAD) offers education for persons arrested for solicitation of prostitution about the legal, social, and health ramifications of the commercial sex trade.
3. The County contracts with Lifeworks Northwest to provide assistance in the design, development and implementation of the SBAD program.
4. The current term of this agreement will expire on December 31, 2016.
5. This amendment will extend the term of the intergovernmental agreement through December 31, 2017.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. That the Commissioner-in-charge is authorized to execute an amendment to Contract No. 30002122 between the City and Multnomah County as outlined in a form similar to the amendment attached as Exhibit A.
- b. The Chief of Police and the Project Manager are authorized to execute amendments to the scope of services or the terms and conditions of this Agreement, provided the changes do not increase the amount of annual compensation or increase the City's financial risk.


