

ORDINANCE No. 188108

*Accept a grant in the amount of \$15,000 from KaBOOM! Play Everywhere Challenge for Sitton Elementary and George Middle School Walking School Bus Stops (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Portland Bureau of Transportation applied to KaBOOM!, Inc. for a grant in the amount of \$15,000 for a network of walking school bus stops that will be installed through a partnership with City Repair and the Village Building Convergence. The grant was applied for on *July 29, 2016*; and
2. KaBOOM!, Inc. has notified the City of Portland that it will award a grant for the Sitton Elementary and George Middle School Walking School Bus Stops to the Portland Bureau of Transportation in the amount of \$15,000;
3. The Portland Bureau of Transportation will provide technical assistance and permit authorization for small community kiosks to be installed to encourage students to walk together to school.
4. City Repair will lead community facilitation, an interactive design process, provide training to community members about how to facilitate small neighborhood projects, and implement the small community kiosks during the Village Building Convergence.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:


- a. The Commissioner-in-Charge is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland a grant from the KaBOOM!, Inc. for the Sitton Elementary and George Middle School Walking School Bus Stops in the amount of \$15,000. to execute the contract attached as Exhibit A.
- b. The budget will be adjusted in the Spring Budget Monitoring Process to reflect these grant funds.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay the City's ability to perform the activities authorized by the grant; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
