ORDINANCE NO. 188109

* Authorize application and accept a grant in the amount of \$100,000 and appropriate \$67,000 for FY 2016-17 from Oregon Impact for overtime reimbursement for participation in DUII High Visibility Enforcement events during Federal Fiscal Year 2016-17 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Oregon Impact has notified the City that it will award a grant for an Oregon Impact DUII High Visibility Enforcement (HVE) Grant for Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 2016-17 in the amount of \$100,000;
- 2. The Police Bureau wishes to apply for and accept the Oregon Impact grant award;
- 3. Oregon Impact reimburses officer overtime at a rate of \$65.87 per hour for enforcement activities specified towards High Visibility Enforcement patrol;
- 4. Oregon Impact requires that agencies receiving funds participate in two National Highway Traffic Safety Administration pre-determined HVE national events with Oregon Association of Chiefs of Police and the Oregon State Police; Christmas 2016/New Year 2017 and Labor Day 2017;
- 5. Oregon Impact requires that agencies initiate HVE news media informing the public what the HVEs are about; both pre- and post- media notification is required;
- 6. Oregon Impact requires that agencies complete and submit an *Oregon Impact DUII Overtime Enforcement Report* each month, noting individual office reports for each shift and include copies of pre- and post-media releases;
- 7. Local match in the amount of \$125,052.84 is required by matching straight-time enforcement hours, which will be funded by existing bureau General Fund appropriation.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Chief of Police is hereby authorized to make application to Oregon Impact in a form similar to the application attached as Exhibit A for a grant in the amount of \$100,000.
- b. The Chief of Police is authorized to provide such information and assurances as are required for the grant period.
- c. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City a grant from Oregon Impact for the FFY 2016-17 DUII Overtime Enforcement Grant program in the amount of \$100,000.

d. The FY 2016-17 budget is hereby amended as follows:

<u>GRANTS FUND</u> Fund - 217 Business Area - PL Bureau Program Expenses - \$67,000

- e. The Office of Management & Finance Grants Management Division is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Chief and Mayor's behalves.
- f. The Chief of the Police Bureau of the City of Portland is authorized to accept on behalf of the City any subsequent modifications by Oregon Impact DUII HVE grant program provided such modifications do not increase the City's financial obligation or risk. Any modifications that increase the City's financial obligation or risk must be authorized by Council.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because of critical deadlines in the grant application process. Therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
