Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

The purpose of this IGA is to provide technical assistance and business consultation services to support small/women-owned/minority-owned business who are interested in measuring, reporting and adopting current and new business practices championed by B Corps, in an effort to increase the number and diversity of certified B Corps in Portland.

B Corp certification is increasing becoming a tool for businesses to demonstrate their commitment to "doing good" for their employees, their community and the environment. For businesses who are interested in becoming certified, it is a complex process that can be burdensome if they don't have the necessary time, resources, or education. This can be especially difficult for Portland's small/women-owned/minority-businesses.
