## ORDINANCE No. 188131

Authorize a contract with the lowest responsible bidder for construction of the Alder Pump Station Upgrade, Project No. E10359, for an estimated construction cost of \$3,500,000 (Ordinance)

#### The City of Portland ordains:

#### Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Bureau of Environmental Services (BES) needs to upgrade the Alder pump station to meet current BES standards, and to provide long-term reliability.
- 2. The level of confidence in the estimated cost for a construction contract for the Alder Pump Station Upgrade project is high.
- 3. The estimated cost is \$3,500,000. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY 2017-FY2021 CIP, Bureau of Environmental Services, Project number E10359.

### NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Commissioner-in-Charge is authorized to execute a contract with the lowest responsive bidder for the purposes described in Section 1.
- b. The Mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to pay for the contract from the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget.
