

ORDINANCE No.

*Authorize a contract with the lowest responsible bidder for the Foster Streetscape Project, SE 82nd to 90th Ave. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Foster Streetscape Project, SE 82nd to 90th Ave implements the first phase of the Foster Rd Transportation and Streetscape Plan, adopted by City Council in 2014 (Resolution No 36158).
2. In 2015, the Portland Bureau of Transportation (PBOT) entered into a funding intergovernmental agreement with the Portland Development Commission for \$1,940,156 to design and construct the project.
3. Additional funding for the project comes from the Fixing Our Streets Program to repave Foster Rd and PBOT's Transportation System Development Charge Program.
4. Project design is completed and now PBOT is proceeding with bidding the project for construction.
5. The Bureau of Transportation has funds budgeted in FY 16/17 and 17/18 for construction, inspection and management of the project.
6. The Bureau's level of confidence in the cost estimates for this project is moderate, as plans, specifications, and estimates are now completed and the project is ready for bidding.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. Upon the Council's acceptance of the Chief Procurement Officer's report recommending the lowest responsible bidder, the Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to negotiate and execute a contract, provided the contract has been approved as to form by the City Attorney's office.
- b. The Auditor to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to T00582 when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.


