## ORDINANCE No. 188146

\* Authorize contract with the World Council on City Data for joining a global network of cities that are improving city services and quality of life with open data. (Ordinance).

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The City of Portland publishes information on the results of programs and services through performance measures in City adopted budget documents.

2. The City invests on increasing the reliability and accuracy of monitoring systems to produce the best informed policy decisions. The expert certification of its performance management system in accordance to global standards is a means to improve the rigor and validity of measures and findings.

3. The City sees value in participating in a global network of performance data for cities, understanding that the rapid urbanization of the global population provides an opportunity to learn innovative solutions to shared challenges.

4. ISO 37120 Sustainable Development of Communities (ISO 37120) is an international standard that establishes definitions and methodologies for a set of city indicators to steer and measure delivery of city services.

5. The World Council on City Data (WCCD) is a Canadian nonprofit that provides cities that are improving services and quality of life through open city data with certification services in accordance to ISO 37120 and an international platform for standardized urban metrics named WCCD Global Cities Registry.

6. WCCD notified the City on a letter dated June 2, 2016 (Exhibit A) that Portland has been selected for joining the WCCD Global Cities Registry at an annual cost of \$4,950.

7. WCCD has agreed to provide services towards the certification and registration of Portland in the WCCD Global Cities Registry as described in the attached Certification and Registration Agreement (Exhibit A).

8. The City through lead coordination of the City Budget Office and the Bureau of Planning and Sustainability will coordinate with appropriate City bureau teams necessary for project success.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. The City Budget Director, or designee, is hereby authorized to enter into an Agreement, in a form substantially similar to Exhibit B attached hereto and as approved to form by the City Attorney, with the World Council on City Data. The City Budget Director, or designee, is further authorized to execute written amendments to the scope of work or terms and conditions of the agreement, provided

any amended agreement is approved to form by the City Attorney and the changes do not increase the financial risk or impose greater liability on the City.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay the City's ability to perform the activities detailed in the agreement; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.


