

ORDINANCE NO. 188148

Authorize a contract with the lowest responsible bidder for the construction of the Greenleaf Pump Station Project at an estimated cost of \$1,275,000 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Water Bureau requires the replacement of the existing Greenleaf Pump Station located in the northwest hills of Portland.
2. The residential area surrounding the Greenleaf Pump Station does not have adequate water supply for fire protection. The existing Penridge Tank located north of the Greenleaf site will be demolished as the flow upgrades will render the Penridge Tank superfluous as it has reached the end of its service life.
3. The engineer's estimate for this construction contract action is \$1,275,000 with a moderate confidence level.
4. The total Project cost is estimated at \$1,707,310 and is available for the FY 2016-17 budget and the remaining will be requested in the FY 2017-18 and FY 2018-19 budgets.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. Upon the Council's acceptance of the Chief Procurement Officer's report recommending the lowest responsible bidder, the Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to negotiate and execute a contract, provided the contract has been approved as to form by the City Attorney's office.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver checks chargeable to the Water Fund when demand is presented and approved by the proper authorities.


