

## ORDINANCE No. 188157

\*Authorize a Special Appropriation grant agreement with Focus on Youth in an amount not to exceed \$60,110 to fund expansion of their program and construction of an attached garage for use as an indoor classroom/demonstration kitchen and bathroom for students and volunteers (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Focus on Youth is a non-profit corporation with a mission to empower at-risk and homeless youth through sustainable gardening and photography.
2. Focus on Youth works directly with New Avenues for Youth and Outside In, helping homeless youth become active participants in the planting and harvesting of organic fruit, vegetables, flowers and herbs, and then learn food safety and how to prepare healthy meals on-site from their harvest.
3. Focus on Youth's students grew over a ton of fresh produce in 2015 and donated half of their harvest to help feed low-income seniors and families through the Neighborhood House food pantry.
4. Focus on Youth's students earn two science credits and one photography credit toward their GEDs by participating in the Focus on Youth programs.
5. Focus on Youth's special appropriations grant funding will allow them to expand their program and serve more students.
6. Focus on Youth's mission is consistent with the Council desire for equity and inclusion, educated youth, healthier people, and healthy watersheds.
7. Focus on Youth submitted a grant application for the FY2016-17 special appropriations grants competitive process and was selected as one of the twenty to be awarded a grant.
8. In accordance with the FY2016-17 Budget, the City now desires to make a grant to Focus on Youth in an amount not to exceed \$60,110.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a grant agreement, as outlined in a form substantially in accordance with the agreement attached as Exhibit A, at a cost not to exceed \$60,110.00.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver payment chargeable to the Fiscal Year 2016-17 Budget

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay Focus on Youth's ability to perform the activities authorized by the grant. Therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.

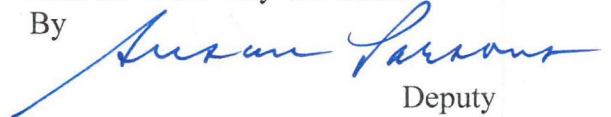
