ORDINANCE No. 188159

*Authorize a contract with Toole Design Group, LLC for the development of Safe Routes to School Project Planning in the amount of \$345,366 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The City of Portland's Fixing our Streets Program allocated eight million dollars in investments to ten high school attendance areas in Portland to make the routes to the schools in these areas safer and more convenient for kids to use.
- 2. The Portland Bureau of Transportation (PBOT) is proposing to develop a comprehensive unconstrained project list for safe routes to school infrastructure needs on routes to each school in the City.
- 3. The Safe Routes to School project planning will identify priorities in each high school attendance area and will identify specific projects for Fixing our Streets funds.
- 4. The project will include a strategic plan for education and outreach to support and coordinate with infrastructure investments in all ten high school attendance areas.
- 5. Toole Design Group, LLC was selected through a competitive bid process for the Safe Routes to School Project Planning.
- 6. The Bureau's level of confidence in the cost estimates for this project is high because the price and scope were negotiated with the firm.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. That the Commissioner-in-Charge is hereby authorized to execute a contract between Toole Design Group, LLC and the City of Portland in an amount not to exceed \$345,366 as outlined in a form similar to the contract attached as Exhibit A.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because both the consultant and PBOT are ready to begin work on the project therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
