## ORDINANCE NO. 188166 As Amended

\*Provide one-month City paid health insurance to certain staff of outgoing elected officials' Offices (Ordinance)

## The City of Portland ordains:

## Section 1. The Council Finds:

- 1. City Commissioner Steve Novick and Mayor Charlie Hales will complete their terms of office effective December 31, 2016.
- 2. To enable each office to fulfill their duties and obligations to the City for the remainder of their terms, a certain level of staffing in each elected official's office is required through the end of December 2016.
- 3. Staff who have committed to remain in Comm. Novick and Mayor Hales offices through the end of their term may not have secured employment that provides health care coverage effective January 1, 2017, nor may they have other coverage available to them as a qualified dependent of other employer sponsored coverage.
- 4. Continuing to provide services to the public and providing an orderly transition is an important goal, and in recognition of those staff who contributed to this goal by remaining employed by the elected officials' offices it is appropriate for the City to pay the cost of COBRA coverage for one month for those staff members identified in Exhibit 1 (attached). The contribution will include coverage for those staff members and their covered qualified dependents.

## NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor or the Director of Human Resources is hereby authorized to provide payment to the Health Operating Fund for the month of January, equal to the City's Employer Contribution and 2% COBRA administration fee for continuing health care insurance coverage at the present level of coverage for those staff identified in Exhibit 1.
- b. The impacted staff will be responsible for the Employee Contribution at the present level of coverage.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists in order to avoid undue and costly delay in providing benefits to plan participants; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
