### Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

Council passed Ordinance 188061 approving the FY 2016-17 Fall Supplemental Budget and other budget-related changes on October 26<sup>th</sup>, 2016. It has since come the attention of the City Budget Office that the wrong fiscal years were mistakenly included in two areas of that Ordinance: the direction to adjust the Current Appropriation Level target for the Housing Bureau was mistakenly directed for FY 2016-17 when the intent was to begin the adjustment in FY 2017-18; and the emergency clause stated that an emergency existed to implement the FY 2015-16 Fall budget adjustments when the correct year is FY 2016-17. This ordinance remedies these technical errors.

#### Financial and budgetary impacts:

On June 22, 2016, Council passed Ordinance #187843, the Joint Office of Homeless Services Intergovernmental Agreement ("the IGA"). Per the terms of the IGA, the City will maintain a baseline funding level of \$15.0 million, adjusted for inflation, beginning in FY 2016-17. The Portland Housing Bureau's FY 2017-18 base budget currently includes \$11,494,774 in ongoing General Fund support for Joint Office programming, leaving a shortfall of \$3,505,226 to be compliant with the IGA. Per direction by Council, the Portland Housing Bureau's CAL target will be increased by \$3,505,226 to meet the IGA terms.

In FY 2016-17, the Portland Housing Bureau is providing to the Joint Office well over the \$15 million baseline level of funding required per the IGA. Ordinance 188061 mistakenly directed the City Budget Office to increase the FY 2016-17 appropriation level which does not require an increase. The intent was to fill the shortfall beginning in FY 2017-18, and this Ordinance remedies this error by ensuring that \$3,505,226 is added to the Portland Housing Bureau's FY 2017-18 Current Appropriation Level.

There are no other changes to the original Ordinance that create financial or budgetary impacts.

#### Community impacts and community involvement:

As this ordinance simply corrects for a technical error of a previous ordinance, there are no community impacts, and the construction of this ordinance was not part of a community involvement process.
