

ORDINANCE No. 188183

*Authorize a Special Appropriation grant agreement with Oregon BRAVO Youth Orchestras in an amount not to exceed \$50,000 to expand their intensive orchestral program in Portland (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Oregon BRAVO Youth Orchestras is a non-profit corporation transforming the lives of underserved youth through intensive orchestral music instruction emphasizing collaboration, promoting self-confidence, and creating a community where children thrive in Portland.
2. Oregon BRAVO Youth Orchestras' project will expand their intensive orchestral program for underserved youth to the George Middle School in Portland.
3. Oregon BRAVO Youth Orchestras submitted a grant application for the FY2016-17 special appropriations grants competitive process and was selected as one of the twenty to be awarded a grant.
4. Oregon BRAVO Youth Orchestras' mission is consistent with Council's desire for equity and inclusion, educated youth, and complete neighborhoods.
5. In accordance with the FY2016-17 Budget, the City now desires to make a grant to Oregon BRAVO Youth Orchestras in an amount not to exceed \$50,000.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a grant agreement, as outlined in a form substantially in accordance with the agreement attached as Exhibit A, at a cost not to exceed \$50,000.00.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver payment chargeable to the Fiscal Year 2016-17 Budget


