

# ORDINANCE No. 188189

Authorize a contract with the lowest responsible bidder for the Airport Way 1 Pump Station Improvements and AW03 Forcemain Repair Project No. E10529 for an estimated construction cost of \$2,374,000 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Bureau of Environmental Services (BES) needs to improve the Airport Way 1 Pump Station and repair the forcemain at Airport Way 3 Pump Station to meet current BES standards, and to provide long-term reliability.
2. The level of confidence in the estimated cost for a construction contract for the Airport Way 1 Pump Station Improvements and AW03 Forcemain Repair project is high.
3. The estimated cost is \$2,374,000. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY2017-FY2021 CIP, Bureau of Environmental Services, WBS 10529.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. Upon the Council's acceptance of the Chief Procurement Officer's report recommending the lowest responsible bidder, the Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to negotiate and execute a contract, provided the contract has been approved as to form by the City Attorney's office.
- b. The Mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to pay for the contract from the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget.


