I'm asking the Mayor and the City council to review ORS 830.035 and respond to my questions regarding the City of Portland being in violation of ORS 830.035.

Reporting and enforcement

ORS 830.035(1) provides

The sheriff of each county and all other peace officers shall be responsible for the enforcement of this chapter and any regulations made by the State Marine Board pursuant thereto.

Emphasis added. "Peace officers" includes "a member of the Oregon State Police, a sheriff or deputy sheriff and a city police officer." ORS 830.005 (11). Thus, the "Hit & Run", Unsafe operations and Reckless Operation crimes and violations discussed above, the State Police, the Multnomah County Sheriff's Office and the City of Portland Police Department all are responsible for their enforcement, if within their jurisdiction. However, the Marine Board website provides a 'Report A Crime' form as well as a "Boating Accident Report" form:


