## ORDINANCE No. 188197

\*Authorize a Special Appropriation grant agreement with Confluence in an amount not to exceed \$25,000 for the interpretive development and tribal relations portion of the redevelopment of Celilo Park (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

## Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Confluence is a non-profit corporation redeveloping Celilo Park, near The Dalles, Oregon, along the Columbia River.
- 2. Confluence's project is scheduled for completion in 2019, to connect people with the history and cultures of Celilo Falls, a center of commerce, culture and spiritual life for millennia.
- 3. Confluence's project is a redevelopment of the park, including parking lot improvements, a new plaza and three interconnected art/landscape installations.
- 4. Confluence's project includes the interpretive elements of a pavilion to invite visitors to learn more about Celilo Falls, a 70-foot sculpture of the Columbia River, and a 500-foot curved, wooden elevated walkway, or "Arc."
- 5. Confluence's special appropriations funding will be used for the interpretive signage of the installation and tribal consultations necessary to ensure the project remains culturally appropriate.
- 6. Confluence's project is consistent with the Council desire for equity and inclusion and educated youth.
- Confluence submitted a grant application for the FY2016-17 special appropriations grants
  competitive process and was selected as one of the twenty recommended to be awarded a
  grant.
- 8. In accordance with the FY 2016-17 Budget, the City now desires to make a grant to Confluence in an amount not to exceed \$25,000.

## NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a grant agreement, as outlined in a form substantially in accordance with the agreement attached as Exhibit A, at a cost not to exceed \$25,000.00.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver payment chargeable to the Fiscal Year 2016-17 Budget

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay Confluence's ability to perform the activities authorized by the grant. Therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
