## **ORDINANCE No.** 188198

\*Authorize a contract with MAKERS Architecture and Urban Design, LLP for master site and implementation planning for the Kerby/Albina Yard/Municipal Service Center for Bureau of Transportation Maintenance Operations and CityFleet for a total not-to-exceed amount of \$291,088 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

## Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Work under this contract includes needs analyses for Portland Bureau of Transportation (PBOT) and CityFleet to provide a thorough understanding of each agency's needs for maintenance and operations today and into the future; and master site and implementation planning to accommodate those uses at the Kerby/Albina Yard, which is where Portland PBOT Maintenance Operations and CityFleet are currently based.
- 2. The services were advertised under RFP No. 00000293 and two responsive responses were received. The selection committee reviewed and scored the proposals in accordance with PCC 5.68 and selected MAKERS Architecture and Urban Design, LLP.
- 3. The City desires to enter into a PTE contract with MAKERS Architecture and Urban Design, LLP substantially in accordance with Attachment No. 1, for a not-to-exceed contract amount of \$291,088.46.
- 4. The M/W/ESB participation in this contract is 13%.
- 5. Costs for this contract are covered through interagency agreements with PBOT and CityFleet, who split costs 50/50.

## NOW THEREFORE, the Council Directs:

- a. The Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to enter into a contract with Makers Architecture and Urban Design, LLP in an amount not to exceed \$291,088.46 and in a form substantially in conformance with Attachment No. 1.
- b. The Chief Procurement Officer and the Auditor are hereby authorized to pay Makers Architecture and Urban Design, LLP when demand is presented and approved by the proper authorities.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists to prevent delays in proceeding with the project. Therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
