

ORDINANCE No. 188200

- * Accept and appropriate a grant in the amount of \$23,130 from Oregon State Fire Marshal 2016 Hazardous Materials Emergency Preparedness Grant for advanced hazardous materials training for Portland Fire & Rescue (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds

1. Council authorized Portland Fire & Rescue (PF&R) to apply to the Oregon State Fire Marshal (OSFM) for a HMEP sub grant in the amount of \$33,000 for Advance HazMat Life Support and Tox-Medic training via Ordinance 187622 on March 9, 2016; and
2. OSFM has notified the City of Portland that it will award a grant for Advance HazMat Life Support and Tox-Medic training in the amount of \$23,130; and
3. The grant requires a 20% match contribution. The City of Portland, PF&R matching funds of \$5,783 will be provided in the form of in-kind contribution of salary and benefits for the firefighters attending the training. The matching funds are in the adopted PF&R FY 16/17 Operating budget.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland a grant from the Oregon State Fire Marshal for Advance HazMat Life Support and Tox-Medic training in the amount of \$23,130 and to execute an intergovernmental agreement in a form similar to the agreement attached as Exhibit A.
- b. The FY 2016/2017 budget is hereby amended as follows:

GRANTS FUND

Fund 217

Business Area – FR

Bureau Program Expenses – \$23,130


- c. The Office of Management & Finance Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.

- d. The Fire Chief of Portland Fire & Rescue of the City of Portland is authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland any subsequent modifications by Oregon State Fire Marshal for HMEP grant, provided such modifications do not increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk. Any modifications that increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk must be authorized by the Portland City Council.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay the City's ability to perform the activities authorized by the grant. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
