

ORDINANCE No. 188202

- * Authorize a contract with Legacy Good Samaritan Medical Center for a Mobile Healthcare Services Pilot Program for post-hospital care services for at-risk patients (Ordinance; Contract No. 30005639)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Legacy Good Samaritan Medical Center (Legacy), a general acute care hospital, desires to engage community healthcare partners to provide post-hospital care for at-risk patients to improve continuity of care and reduce additional, unnecessary hospitalization.
2. Portland Fire & Rescue has an interest in improving the use of its Emergency Medical Services resources and reducing the number of unnecessary, non-emergency medical service calls.
3. Portland Fire & Rescue desires to partner with Legacy as an independent contractor to perform follow-up communication and care to selected Legacy patients as part of a six-month pilot program to assess the effectiveness of a post-hospitalization care partnership.
4. Legacy desires to contract Portland Fire & Rescue to provide the services as described in the attached agreement.
5. The pilot program will be referred to as the Mobile Healthcare Services Program.
6. The attached Agreement defines the services and responsibilities of Portland Fire & Rescue and Legacy Health Systems Inc, on behalf of Legacy Good Samaritan Medical Center.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Commissioner-in-Charge is authorized to execute an agreement with Legacy Health Systems, Inc., for a Mobile Healthcare Services Pilot Program, in a form substantially in accordance with the agreement attached as Exhibit A.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because Legacy Good Samaritan Medical Center has an immediate and critical need for a community healthcare partner to provide post-hospitalization services and additional delay would jeopardize the pending agreement, therefore, this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
