TO THE COUNCIL:

On March 30, 2016, Council approved Ordinance 187655 directing Procurement Services to competitively solicit the SW Bond Ave, Surcharge and Retaining Wall Improvements project in accordance with PCC 5.34. The Chief Procurement Officer has advertised and received bids for Bid Number 00000431 on behalf of the Portland Bureau of Transportation (PBOT), with a project construction estimate of \$3,260,619.00. PBOT rated the Project Estimate confidence level as moderate.

Bids were due and opened on December 20, 2016, and eight (8) bids were received. The bid of McDonald Excavating, Inc. was responsive to the solicitation requirements; therefore it is recommended that that McDonald Excavating's bid be accepted at the estimated unit prices quoted for a total bid amount of \$3,142,478.69.

The City identified an aspirational goal for D/M/W/ESB subcontractor and supplier utilization at 20% of the hard construction costs for the project.

There is \$628,823.00 (20%) D/M/W/ESB utilization identified towards the goal. DBE subcontractor/supplier participation represents 15.86% of the total subcontracting/supplier dollars apportioned and WBE subcontractor/supplier participation represents 4.1% of the total subcontracting/supplier dollars apportioned as follows:

WBE – Trucking at \$130,435.00

McDonald Excavating, Inc. is located in Washougal, WA. McDonald Excavating, Inc. as the prime contractor will be self-performing the erosion control, clearing and grubbing, excavation, grading, drainage, retaining wall construction, granular structural backfill and embankment. for a total of \$2,053,638.29. They have a current City of Portland Business Tax Registration and EEO Certification, and are in Full Compliance with the Equal Benefits Program.

Funds are available in PBOT Owner Cost Centers TRED000009.

It is recommended that Performance and Payment Bonds each at 100% of the contract amount be furnished by the contractor. Further, it is also recommended that a two (2) year maintenance/warranty Bond for 20% of the final contract amount be furnished by the contractor before final payment is released.
