



Local Improvement District (42%): \$1,108,417 (eligible for system development charge credits)

PBOT Pavement Preservation Funds (58%): \$1,500,000

Total PBOT Project (100%): \$2,608,417 LID leverages \$1.00 of existing resources into \$1.74

Additional \$700,000 in Permit Job Resources for Sidewalk Infill: Complete missing link from north of NW 15th Ave. to NW 17th Ave.
