

**IMPACT STATEMENT**

**Legislation title:** \* Authorize amendments to the Voluntary Retirement Incentive Program (VRIP) for 2017, Health Reimbursement Account Plan Document and Summary Plan Description administered by the Bureau of Human Resources, Health & Financial Benefits Office through June 30, 2022. (Ordinance)

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**Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:**

Purpose of amendment is to reinstate the Voluntary Retirement Incentive Program (VRIP) through June 30, 2017 as a retirement incentive option offered to employees eligible for retirement under PERS/OPSRP or FPDR.

**Financial and budgetary impacts:**

The incentive program aims to reduce general fund bureau costs through a voluntary reduction of staff through retirement and create opportunities to restructure/realign work, thereby resulting in short and long-term savings. The Health Fund includes the appropriation in support of the administrative costs associated with the Voluntary Retirement Incentive Program. All expected administrative costs are budgeted as part of existing contracts with program vendors.
