

# ORDINANCE No. 188208

Authorize contract with the lowest responsible bidder for construction of Mt Scott-Arleta Sewer Rehabilitation Project No. E10678 for \$1,910,000 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Bureau of Environmental Services (BES) needs to rehabilitate approximately 5,500 feet of sewer main line in the southeast neighborhoods of Mt. Scott-Arleta and Woodstock.
2. Environmental Services along with Murray, Smith & Associates has prepared plans and specifications for rehabilitating or replacing the deteriorated sewer pipe, including sewer manholes and service laterals
3. The estimated cost is \$1,910,000. To comply with Council Resolution No. 36430 this estimate has been assigned a level of confidence of High.
4. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY 2017 Budget, Bureau of Environmental Services, WBS Element E10678.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:


- a. Upon the Council's acceptance of the Chief Procurement Officer's report recommending the lowest responsive bidder, the Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to negotiate and execute a contract, provided the contract has been approved as to form by the City Attorney's office.
- b. The Mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to pay for the contract from the Sewer System Operating Fund.
