

ORDINANCE No. 188216

Amend contract with Ryan Sullivan dba Paste in Place to increase amount by \$38,000 to provide additional graphic design and identity services for Safe Routes to School and Active Transportation. (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 30004642)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The City of Portland's Vision Zero program within the Active Transportation and Safety Division in the Bureau of Transportation is working to eliminate deaths and serious injuries from our streets by 2025.
2. In December, 2016 Portland City Council unanimously approved the Vision Zero Action Plan.
3. In June 2015, a contract was established with Ryan Sullivan dba Paste in Place to provide graphic design and identity services for the Vision Zero program.
4. Additional graphic design and identity needs have been identified within the Active Transportation and Safety Division that align with the Vision Zero goals of eliminating traffic deaths and serious injuries while maintaining and fostering Portland's reputation as a walkable, bikeable, livable city.
5. The Bureau's level of confidence in the cost estimates for this project is High.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. That the Commissioner-in-Charge is hereby authorized to execute the Contract Amendment #2 for Contract 30004642 in a form similar to the attached as Exhibit A.

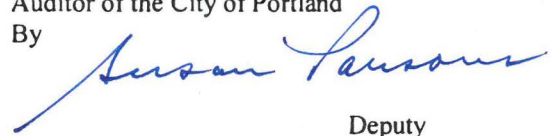
