ORDINANCE No. 188217

Authorize a contract with the lowest responsible bidder for construction of the Southeast Interceptor Rehabilitation Project No. E10030 for \$4,347,967 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Bureau of Environmental Services (BES) needs to rehabilitate approximately 7,220 feet of the Southeast Interceptor, a combined sewer pipe in the southeast Portland neighborhood, which is in deteriorated condition.
- 2. BES has prepared plans and specifications for rehabilitating the Southeast Interceptor via a combination of cementitious grout injection and structural lining repairs from inside the pipe.
- 3. The estimated cost is \$4,347,967. The level of confidence is high. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY2017-FY2021 CIP, Bureau of Environmental Services, WBS Element E10030.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. Upon the Council's acceptance of the Chief Procurement Officer's report recommending the lowest responsible bidder, the Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to negotiate and execute a contract, provided the contract has been approved as to form by the City Attorney's office.
- b. The Mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to pay for the contract from the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget.
