- Section 2 - Buckman and Hosford-Abernathy neighborhood



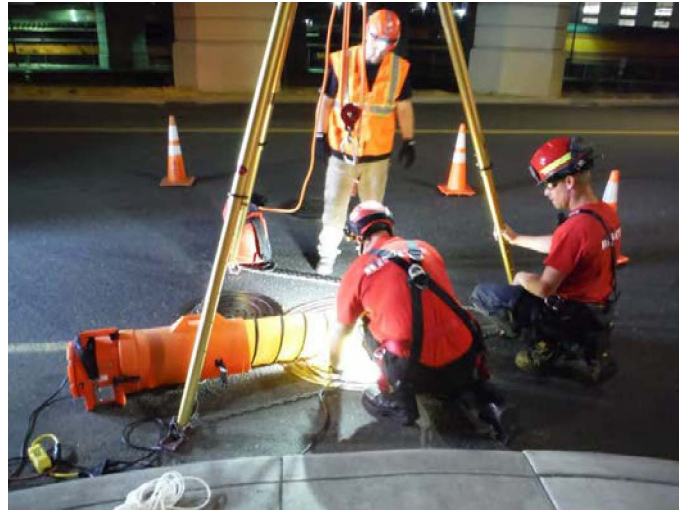
Project Scope

- Rehabilitate 6,000 LF of pipe
- Grouting is dominant method
- Soil Reinforcement at 3 manholes in Grand Avenue
