

ORDINANCE No. 188222

Authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with the City of Beaverton and Metro to revise the urban service boundary for the unincorporated areas between the Cities of Beaverton and Portland (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Oregon's Statewide Planning Goal 2 requires that adjacent, and nearly adjacent, comprehensive plans be coordinated with one another.
2. Oregon Revised Statutes, Chapter 195, provides for coordination agreements that assign unincorporated land between nearly adjacent cities to one city or another for future service provision.
3. Twenty years ago Metro employed its regional coordination authority to set an urban services boundary that allocated disputed unincorporated land between the cities of Portland and Beaverton to one city or the other. The Metro Ordinance is attached as Attachment 3 of this ordinance.
4. The urban services boundary adopted by Portland's *2035 Comprehensive Plan* Map contains minor modifications to the boundary set by Metro, and these modifications benefited from the review, coordination and approval of the City of Beaverton. The modified boundary is depicted on Exhibit C of Portland Ordinance 187832, June 15, 2016.
5. Both Cities wish to memorialize their cooperation in an intergovernmental agreement that provides for continued coordination as both cities carry out their updated plans. The intergovernmental agreement is attached as Attachment 1 of this ordinance.
6. The Beaverton City Council authorized the Mayor of Beaverton to approve and execute the intergovernmental agreement. The Beaverton authorization is attached as Attachment 2 of this ordinance.
7. No City of Portland funds required.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is authorized to approve and execute the intergovernmental agreement, which is attached as Attachment 1 of this ordinance.
