Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

The Portland City Council adopted a new 2035 Comprehensive Plan and a new Comprehensive Plan Map. A revised urban service boundary is a feature on the new map. These revisions were made with the participation of Beaverton and Metro. The intergovernmental agreement explains how Portland, Beaverton and Metro will observe the amended service boundary.

Financial and budgetary impacts:

There is no immediate fiscal impact. Over the long term the agreement provides for a net increase in the number of unincorporated properties that might eventually become part of the City of Portland.

Community impacts and community involvement:

The urban service boundary amendments benefited from the community involvement provided for the new *Comprehensive Plan Map*. Adopting the map was the final land use decision. This ordinance, while not a land use decision, does provide new opportunities for multi-jurisdictional coordination of future urban services. The Planning and Sustainability Commission reviewed the model upon which this interagency agreement is based on September 8, 2015.
